## **COVID 19 Protocol for Mitigating Exposure - Sprint Electrical Service, Inc.**

## Novel Coronavirus known as COVID-19 is causing a lot of concern for individuals and businesses.

**Mission Critical Core Functions** - Our number one priority; to effectively service our essential business customers in a safe and timely manner. The new safety and health procedures outlined below will be followed by each individual employee at this most critical time in business and in our community's health.

• **Disinfect all "high touch" areas** at the beginning of each work day, mid-day and end of day. "High touch surfaces include gang-box handles, tooling, scissors lifts hand rails and gear box, and anything else that is routinely touched throughout the day. Each job site is equipped with disinfectant spray, paper towels, and hand sanitizer.

• **SESI shop personnel will disinfect** the inside of each work truck, steering wheels, console, gear shifters, radio, etc. This will be done each day upon return of work vehicles. Each truck will be stocked with disinfectant spray and towels in the event additional disinfectant in needed.

• Beginning May 1, individuals will be required to wear a face-covering or a mask when in all facilities. SESI has issued each employee cloth face masks to meet this requirement.

• **Maintain Social Distancing protocol** of at least a six foot distance between yourself and others.

• Wash your hands often throughout the day with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom, before eating, and after blowing your nose, coughing or sneezing. If you don't have soap or water, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer with at least 60 percent alcohol. We have also provided gloves to each employee, however, it's important to remember sanitizing gloves is just as important as your hands, if using gloves.

• Avoid touching your face, eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands or after touching surfaces.

• NO ONE allowed to go to work sites if feeling sick.

• We follow these guidelines, along with shelter in place, while not working to mitigate exposure to anyone who may be sick.
